### II. Welcome Remarks from Chair-Governor Doug Ducey

Governor Ducey welcomed the Board members and thanked the University of Arizona for hosting the first Arizona Commerce Authority Board of Directors Board Meeting. He recognized the newest board members, Wick Pilcher, Dr. Wyatt Decker, Kimberly Smith, David Goldstein, Mark Bonsall, Dr. Taylor Lawrence, and Mignonne Hollis. He highlighted the exciting announcement that Caterpillar Inc. relocating its surface mining and technology division headquarters in downtown Tucson. Governor Ducey also discussed the 2016 legislative session. He highlighted the passage of Prop.123 as a huge victory for public education in Arizona along with SB 1501, HB 2666, HB 2584. This session, he acted on 374 bill, signing 349 and vetoing 14 and proclaiming May as Small Business month in Arizona. Lastly, the Governor expressed the tireless efforts to make Arizona the best place in the nation to live, work and do business. He concluded by proudly stating the Arizona's ranking has risen to number six in the country on Chief Executive's Best States for Business list.
