II. Welcome

Audit Committee Chair Victor Smith welcomed the committee, ACA staff and CliftonLarsonAllen, LLP representatives to the meeting.

A. Approval of Fiscal Year 2018 Financial Audit Report Issuance

Ms. Dietrich provided an overview of the ACA's Fiscal Year 2018 Financial Statements.

Ms. Dietrich reported that CliftonLarsonAllen, LLP would be issuing an unmodified/"clean" financial audit opinion.

Ms. Dietrich provided an overview of the Management's Discussion and Analysis and the Fiscal Year 2018 Financial Statements.

Mr. Goldstein noted that the \$4.7 million listed for expenses for the Arizona Competes Fund (ACF) appeared to be low. Ken Burns explained that the \$4.7 million reflects only the payments for milestones reached on ACF awards. Jean Dietrich referred the Committee to Note 5, which illustrates that the ACF had \$29.2 million in grants outstanding at June 30, 2018.

Ms. Dietrich provided an overview of the notes to the financial statements, highlighting the changes from the previous year.

Ms. Dietrich provided an overview of the internal controls letter. Ms. Dietrich highlighted that no significant deficiencies or weaknesses of internal controls were detected that would prohibit the auditors from expressing an opinion on the ACA's financial statements. Ms. Dietrich also noted that ACA staff was cooperative and timely in their interaction with the audit team.

Mr. Goldstein moved to approve the Fiscal Year 2018 Financial Audit Report as presented. Chair, Mr. Smith seconded the motion. Motion approved.

Mr. Smith thanked the auditors for their work.
