Issue: 5 Arizona Finance Authority Microloan Program FTE

Description of Issue: This is a onetime request to add one fulltime FTE to set up and manage the new \$5M Microbusiness loan

fund program. We anticipate that once the program is in place AFA can self-fund this position.

Proposal: HB 2372 has designated a one-time sum of \$5 million for the establishment of a new Microbusiness loan fund.

The implementation of this fund necessitates the appointment of one full-time employee (FTE). This individual will be responsible for formulating policies, developing programs, conducting marketing efforts, and providing operational assistance. These actions are aimed at facilitating the disbursement of funds to community development financial institutions (CDFIs) operating in Arizona. The CDFIs will then utilize these funds to offer

loans to Microbusinesses within the state.

Alternatives Add this new program to existing AzIDA programs and staff. However, this is a much more targeted financial instrument and AzIDA staff has no experience with these types of programs. In addition, we want to maintain

operating cost to a minimum and AzIDA operating costs are too high for size of this program.

The recommended option stands out as the best choice for several reasons. Firstly, having a centralized point of contact at the Arizona Finance Authority streamlines the process of defining and implementing all necessary components. This centralized approach ensures efficient coordination and communication,

minimizing potential bottlenecks.

Furthermore, given that this is a novel fund, it demands dedicated resources not only on the technical front but also in terms of marketing and community engagement. By allocating specialized efforts in these areas, we can effectively reach and engage the target audience of this program – specifically, independently owned and operated Arizona businesses employing five or fewer individuals. This comprehensive approach enhances the

fund's visibility and ensures its successful outreach, ultimately maximizing its impact and benefit to the

intended beneficiarie.

Impact on Historically Underserved, Marginalized, or Adversely Affected Groups: This program holds the potential to significantly contribute to equity for historically underserved populations in several key ways:

Access to Capital: Historically underserved populations, often facing systemic barriers, struggle to access traditional sources of capital for their microbusinesses. This program's provision of loans through community development financial institutions (CDFIs) can offer a lifeline of financial support to these businesses. By addressing the capital gap, the program enables these populations to start, sustain, or expand their ventures. Targeted Outreach: The program's focus on independently owned and operated businesses with five or fewer employees aligns with the characteristics often seen in historically underserved communities. By tailoring the program to cater to these microbusinesses, it ensures that those who have faced obstacles in accessing opportunities are directly supported.

This initiative maps to Affordable and Thriving Economy – 10,000 new home-grown small businesses in Arizona.

Issue: 6 Population Estimates Require New Data Source to maintain accuracy

Description of Issue:

Because the timeliness, reliability, and consistency of some of the data that OEO traditionally relied on for population estimates has deteriorated in recent years, the State Demographer has been researching alternative methods and data for continuing to produce high quality population estimates. Timely migration data from a location service provider is one promising source that the team identified. This will be an ongoing need. The cost estimate is for the first year. Cost in each future year will be similar (might need to be adjusted slightly upward for inflation unless we lock in the rate for a multi-year contract).

Issue: 6 Population Estimates Require New Data Source to maintain accuracy

Proposal:

As required by Arizona Constitution (Article IX, Section 20) and statutes (A.R.S.§41-1954 A.14 and A.15; A.R.S.§41-5303 A.2; A.R.S.§41-5402 A.1), OEO produces annual population estimates for the State of Arizona and its counties, cities, and towns. The State Demographer's Office within OEO used a "Composite Method" for state and county population estimates during the 2010-2020 decade. The method requires indicator data including births, deaths, public school enrollment, driver's license and ID data, Social Security enrollment, and Medicare enrollment. The method also requires calculating initial ratios between the decennial population of several age groups and the counts from the indicator data collected around the Census Day. These ratios are called "censal ratios." This method served us well in the previous decade, but several factors made it unworkable for the past three years. 1) The Census Bureau did not release population by age data until May 2023. 2) ADOT MVD switched to a new data system in 2020 and the driver's license and ID data from the two systems are not compatible. The data we received from ADOT in the past few years had a lot of irregularities fluctuations. We have been working with ADOT to try to fix the issues and are hopeful that future data sets will be more stable. However, there is no way to go back and re-create compatible 2020 data that is needed for the censal ratios. 3) Public school enrollment data from the pandemic years are not of the quality we need. 4) We used to be able to receive Social Security enrollment data in July to August. The Social Security Administration pushed the release date to November and December in the last two years and will continue that way for future years, too late for our annual population estimates. For our 2021 and 2022 population estimates, we came up with some temporary methods, including short term projections and relying more heavily on housing units. However, we need a more permanent and long-term solution. We found that timely migration data through a location service provider using cell phone data can be that solution.

Alternatives Considered:

As discussed above, we used short-term projections and housing unit method as a temporary solution for 2021 and 2022. We considered continuing to use them for 2023. However, because they were meant to be temporary fixes, the longer we use them, the more errors we are likely to introduce in our population estimates. Therefore, we do not recommend continuing to use them.

Impact of Not Funding This Year:

If funding is not approved then OEO will have to continue using data with iregularties. It was recommended that we not continue collecting data with all the iregularties.

Impact on Historically Underserved, Marginalized, or Adversely Affected Groups: The mission of OEO's population estimates program is "to produce population estimates for Arizona that are as accurate as possible and are based on exemplary research, solid demographic methods, and accurate and consistent input data, thereby enabling the user community to make sound, data-driven decisions." To the extent that our population estimates are more accurate and users including government entities use these estimates to help serve the historically underserved population, this funding will have a positive impact on equity.

How has feedback been incorporated from groups directly impacted by proposal?: Some potential approaches include surveying affected constituents, consulting existing agency advisory groups, meeting with advocacy organizations that represent the affected population(s), asking front-line staff for feedback from clients second-hand, revisiting previous surveys, etc.

The Council for Technical Solution (created by Executive Order 2011-04) advises the State Demographer on the technical means to improve the quality of the population data, methodology, standards, and analytic techniques. Council members have been keenly aware of the difficulties we had over the past three years and are very supportive of the new data and methods that the State Demographer is exploring.

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- 1) Federal-aid Highway Program: The purpose of the Federal-aid Highway Program is to assist the States in providing for construction, preservation, and improvement of highways and bridges on eligible Federal-Aid routes, (including the National Highway System (NHS) an integrated, interconnected transportation system important to interstate commerce and travel), and for other special purpose programs and projects. This program also provides for the construction and improvement of highways in the District of Columbia, Puerto Rico, American Samoa, Guam, the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands and the U.S. Virgin Islands.
- 2) The Federal Lands Highway Program: The Federal Lands Transportation Program (FLTP) provides assistance to the Federal Land Management Agencies (FLMAs) for Federally-owned roads and trails. It provides transportation engineering services and funding for planning, design, construction, and rehabilitation of the highways and bridges that are on or provide access to federally owned lands. The Federal Lands Highway organization also provides training, technology deployment, and engineering services to other customers.
- 3) The Infrastructure Investment and Jobs (IIJA) Act also known as the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law (BIL) is a once-in-a-generation investment in our infrastructure that will help grow the economy, enhance U.S. competitiveness, create good jobs, and build our safe, resilient, and equitable transportation future. BIL provides the basis for FHWA programs and activities through September 30, 2026. It makes an investment of \$350 billion in highway programs. This includes the largest dedicated bridge investment since the construction of the Interstate Highway System. New programs under the BIL focus on key infrastructure priorities including rehabilitating bridges in critical need of repair, reducing carbon emissions, increasing system resilience, removing barriers to connecting communities, and improving mobility and access to economic opportunity. Many of the new programs include eligibility for local governments, Metropolitan Planning Organizations (MPOs), Tribes, and other public authorities, allowing them to compete directly for funding. BIL also continues to focus the program on safety and performance-based investment and on accelerating project delivery through expedited environmental review and elimination of duplicate processes.
- 4) The Highway Infrastructure Programs in the Department of Transportation Appropriations Act, 2018, included two new discretionary programs: Competitive Bridge Program and Nationally Significant Federal Lands and Tribal Projects Program. The Competitive Bridge Program was appropriated \$225 million to be used for highway bridge rehabilitation or replacement projects for States that have a population density of less than 100 individuals per square mile and that demonstrate cost savings by bundling multiple highway bridge projects.
