II. Welcome Remarks from Chair-Governor Doug Ducey

Governor Doug Ducey, Chair, opened the meeting by identifying continued signs of Arizona's strong economy, including the lowest unemployment rate (4.5%) since 2007 and the creation of 18,700 jobs in October. The Governor updated the Board on his recent participation in the Comisión Sonora Arizona Winter Summit in Puerto Peñasco, Sonora as well as the success of the October CEO Forum event held in London, in collaboration with the Arizona Zanjeros. The Governor also highlighted recent national press coverage of Arizona's prominent role in testing

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of driverless vehicles as well as the ranking of three Arizona school districts among the best in the nation.

IV. CEO Report-Sandra Watson (A.R.S. § 38-431.02(K))

President and CEO, Sandra Watson, indicated that the ACA is off to a strong start under its new five-year business plan. Since July 1st, the ACA has worked with 45 clients who have committed to creating 9,937 projected new jobs over the next five years. These jobs have an average wage of \$52,238 (147% higher than current median of \$35,470). In addition, these clients will make \$791 million in capital investments into our communities.

President and CEO, Sandra Watson, welcomed 5 of the ACA's FY 2018 client companies in attendance at the meeting.

President and CEO, Sandra Watson, introduced Kevin Sullivan, SVP-Business Attraction, who showcased current client activity within the business attraction and expansion pipelines for Q2 FY 2018; highlighting California.

President and CEO, Sandra Watson, introduced Matthew Earl Jones, Director, Arizona Office of Film & Digital Media, who provided an overview of the Offices' activities since its reestablishment one year ago.
