II. Small Business Initiatives – Robert Theobald, Small Business Ombudsman/VP

Robert Theobald gave a briefing on Programs for Small Business including the Arizona Innovation Challenge (AIC), ACA Small Business Checklist, Arizona Small Business Boot Camp & Resource Collective, and the Small Business Digital Academy.

III. 2021 ESP Grant Approval – Keith Watkins

Keith Watkins provided an overview of the recommended FY2021 Economic Strength Projects (ESP) Grant recipients including the following:

- Town of Chino Valley: 100% funding request, \$400,000
- City of Nogales: 100% funding request, \$500,000
- Mohave County: 50% funding request, \$250,000

Mayor Doug Nichols motioned to approve the grantees; Jaime Chamberlain seconded the motion; all voted in favor; the motion was approved.

Levi Esquerra requested that we have a briefing from ADOT regarding the previous round of ESP grants and their status at the next RBDAC meeting.

IV. Arizona Commerce Authority update, Keith Watkins, Sr. V.P.

Keith Watkins provided updates ACA's business attraction and expansion projects; semiconductor, electric vehicle, and battery manufacturers; Lucid Motors; and Arizona's official selection for the 2023 Super Bowl.
