II. Welcome Remarks from Chair-Governor Doug Ducey

Governor Doug Ducey, Chair, welcomed members of the Board, provided an update on the continued growth of the Arizona economy and a recent trip to Silicon Valley where he met with several tech and business leaders. The Governor highlighted the decision of TuSimple to establish operations in Tucson to test its self-driving trucks and commended the work of Arizona's public universities and colleges in providing a strong pipeline of talent.

Governor Doug Duce, Chair, then turned the meeting over to President and CEO, Sandra Watson, to present ACA's progress.

III. CEO Report-Sandra Watson



President and CEO, Sandra Watson, began her report by highlighting the results and associated economic impact of the ACA's first Five Year Business Plan. Between FY 2013 and FY 2017, the ACA's clients created 87,132 new jobs at an average wage of \$52,577 and invested \$9.5 billion in capital resulting in an economic output of \$118 billion. President and CEO, Sandra Watson, also highlighted the ACA's FY 2017 results.

President and CEO, Sandra Watson, welcomed 17 of the ACA's FY 2017 client companies in attendance at the meeting.

President and CEO, Sandra Watson introduced Kevin Sullivan, SVP-Business Attraction, who showcase d the current client activity within the business attraction and expansion pipelines for Q1 FY 2018; highlighting California.
