Expanded Seating – Expanded Revenue

Things to consider before starting:

- What size of area will you need for your extension?
- What are your staffing needs?
- What kind of tenting or other structures will you be using?
- If you plan on serving alcohol, what kind of temporary barriers will you use?
- If you plan on serving alcohol, is your temporary space contiguous?
- Do you intend to do food preparation in the extended area?
- Does your landlord have resources available to help with the extension process?

- Authorization from landlord
- Initiate Application
- Extension of Premises (DLLC)
- Insurance Coverage Requirements
- Application Submittal & Review

Extension of Premises Application only for... food preparation activities Fire marshal-local jurisdiction Equipment Schematics Layout Web form-online submittal

Process

Review process (< 1 week)

- No fee
- •Communication with other county departments as needed

Restaurants in Unincorporated Maricopa County

- COVID-19 Pandemic
- Unincorporated
 - County or County Island
- Main County Departments
 - Planning and Development
 - Maricopa County Department of Transportation (MCDOT)

Submittal Requirements

- •As-Built Plan of Development Application
- •Narrative and Aerial or site plan that...
- $\circ \ensuremath{\mathsf{Identifies}}$ the temporary extension area
- $\odot \textsc{Demonstrates}$ how safe pedestrian and vehicular access will be maintained
- Addresses how the expanded dining area:
 Will not impact ADA facilities or public ROW
 Maintain adequate parking
 Will not block fire lanes, loading zones or sight visibility triangles

Process

- Expedited review process (approx. 1 week)
- •No fee
- •Permission from local fire jurisdiction (condition of the approval)
- Expansion into the public ROW will require permission from the jurisdiction that controls the ROW (i.e., local city or MCDOT)
- Building permits only required for extension of electrical or construction of permanent structures
