Nonfarm Employment Increased by 27,700 Jobs over the Month in November 2020 Arizona Unemployment Rate Decreased to 7.8%


The Arizona seasonally-adjusted unemployment rate decreased to 7.8% in November from 7.9% in October. The U.S. seasonally-adjusted unemployment rate decreased to 6.7% in November from 6.9% in October. Over the month, Arizona's seasonally-adjusted labor force increased by 1,475 individuals or 0.04%. Over the year, labor force levels decreased by 13,582 individuals or 0.4%.

Over the Month

Arizona nonfarm employment increased by 27,700 jobs or 1.0% in November. Historically (2010-2019), nonfarm employment has averaged a gain of 28,900 jobs in November.

Over the Year


Arizona nonfarm employment decreased by 83,900 jobs or 2.8% in November. A majority of the losses were recorded in private sector employment (-73,900 jobs), while Government recorded losses of 10,000 jobs in November.

- Trade, Transportation and Utilities (17,700 jobs)
- Construction (2,300 jobs)
- Financial Activities (800 jobs)

Losses were reported in:

- Leisure and Hospitality (-43,800 jobs)
- Professional and Business Services (-30,900 jobs)
- Education and Health Services (-9,600 jobs)
- Manufacturing (-5,200 jobs)
- Information (-4,200 jobs)
- Other Services (-600 jobs)
- Natural Resources and Mining (-400 jobs)




Arizona Year-Over-Year Employment Gain/Loss by Sector

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
