Total Nonfarm Employment Increased by 98,400 Jobs Year Over Year in January 2023 Arizona Unemployment Decreased to 3.8%

The Arizona seasonally adjusted (SA) unemployment rate decreased to 3.8% in January 2023 from 4.0% in December 2022. The U.S. SA unemployment rate decreased to 3.4% in January 2023 from 3.5% in December 2022.

Month over month, Arizona's SA labor force increased by 7,783 individuals, or 0.2%. Year over year, the SA labor force increased by 86,269 individuals, or 2.4%.

Month over month, Arizona not-seasonally adjusted (NSA) total nonfarm employment decreased by 32,600 jobs¹. Year over year, NSA total nonfarm employment increased by 98,400 jobs, or 3.2%. Arizona SA total nonfarm employment increased by 22,700 individuals, or 0.7%, month over month.

Month Over Month

Arizona NSA nonfarm employment decreased by 32,600 jobs in January. Prior to the pandemic (2010-2019), NSA nonfarm employment lost 51,000 jobs on average in January. The government sector² recorded a gain of 2,700 jobs in January, more than the pre-pandemic (2010-2019) average loss of 9,100 jobs. Employment gains in the government sector occurred primarily within State Government (5,400 jobs). The private sector recorded a loss of 35,300 jobs in January, led by losses in Trade, Transportation & Utilities (-16,500 jobs) and Professional & Business Services (-6,400 jobs). Prior to the pandemic (2010-2019), private sector employment averaged a loss of 41,900 jobs in January.

Employment gains were reported in the following sectors:

- Government (2,700 jobs)
- Natural Resources & Mining (200 jobs)

Employment losses were reported in the following sectors:

- Trade, Transportation & Utilities (-16,500 jobs)
- Professional & Business Services (-6,400 jobs)
- Other Services (-3,100 jobs)
- Manufacturing (-2,400 jobs)
- Leisure & Hospitality (-2,400 jobs)
- Financial Activities (-1,800 jobs)
- Construction (-1,200 jobs)

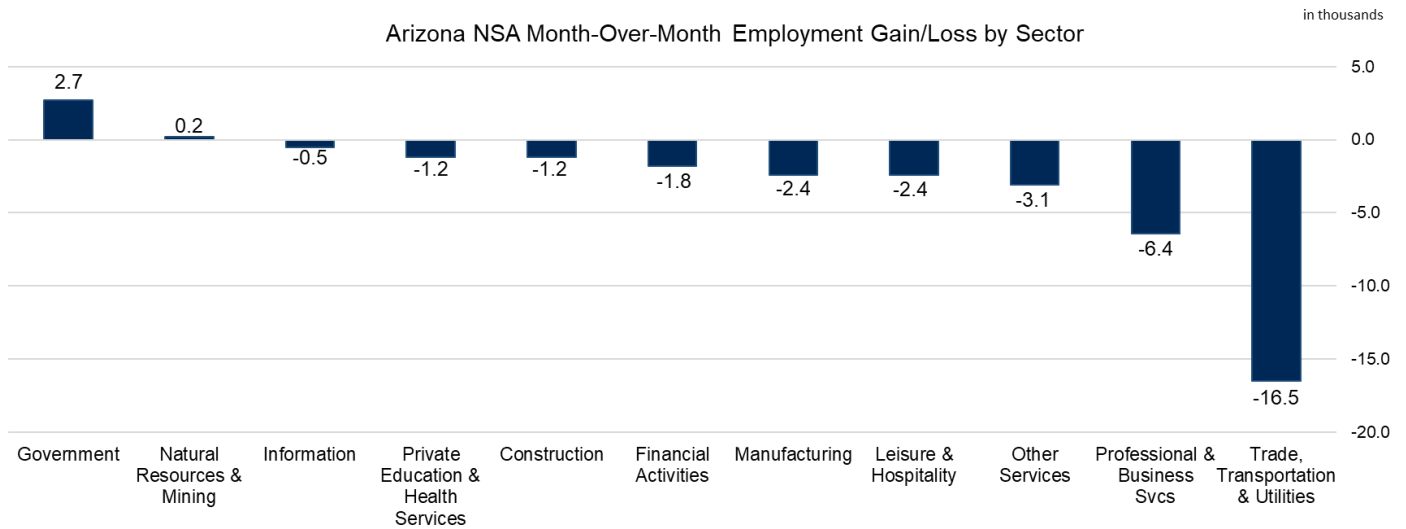

Year Over Year

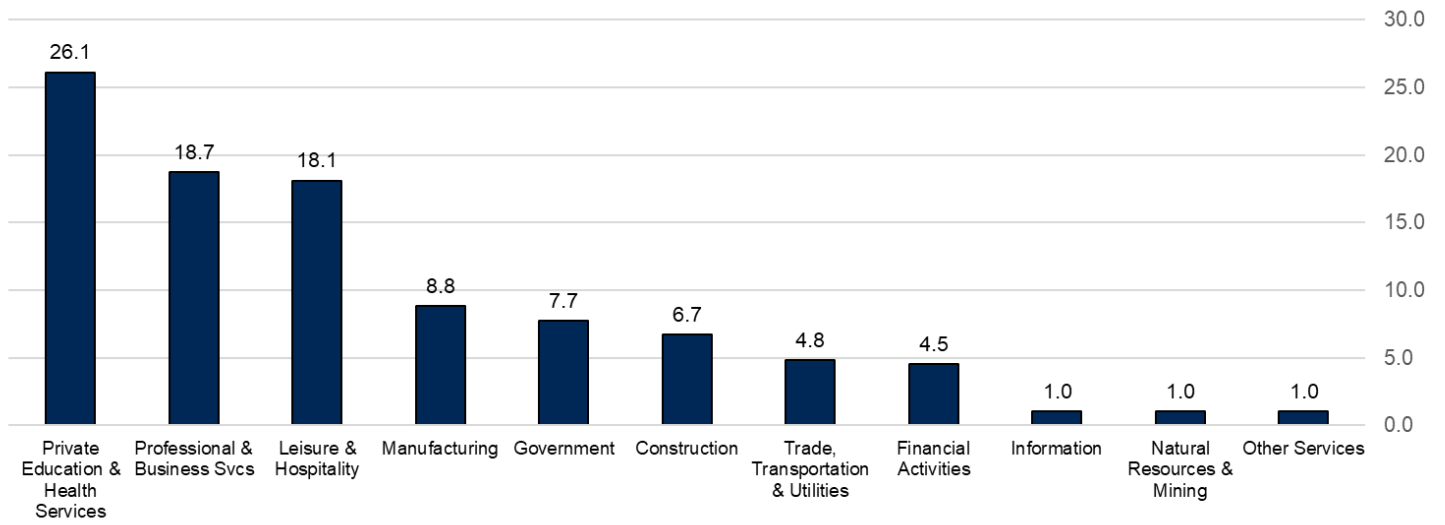
Arizona NSA nonfarm employment increased by 98,400 jobs or 3.2% in January year over year. Private sector employment increased by 90,700 jobs year over year, while government employment increased by 7,700 jobs year over year.

Employment gains were reported in all 11 sectors year over year:

- Private Education & Health Services (26,100 jobs)
- Professional & Business Services (18,700 jobs)
- Leisure & Hospitality (18,100 jobs)
- Manufacturing (8,800 jobs)
- Government (7,700 jobs)
- Construction (6,700 jobs)
- Trade, Transportation & Utilities (4,800 jobs)
- Financial Activities (4,500 jobs)
- Other Services (1,000 jobs)
- Information (1,000 jobs)
- Natural Resources & Mining (1,000 jobs)

in thousands

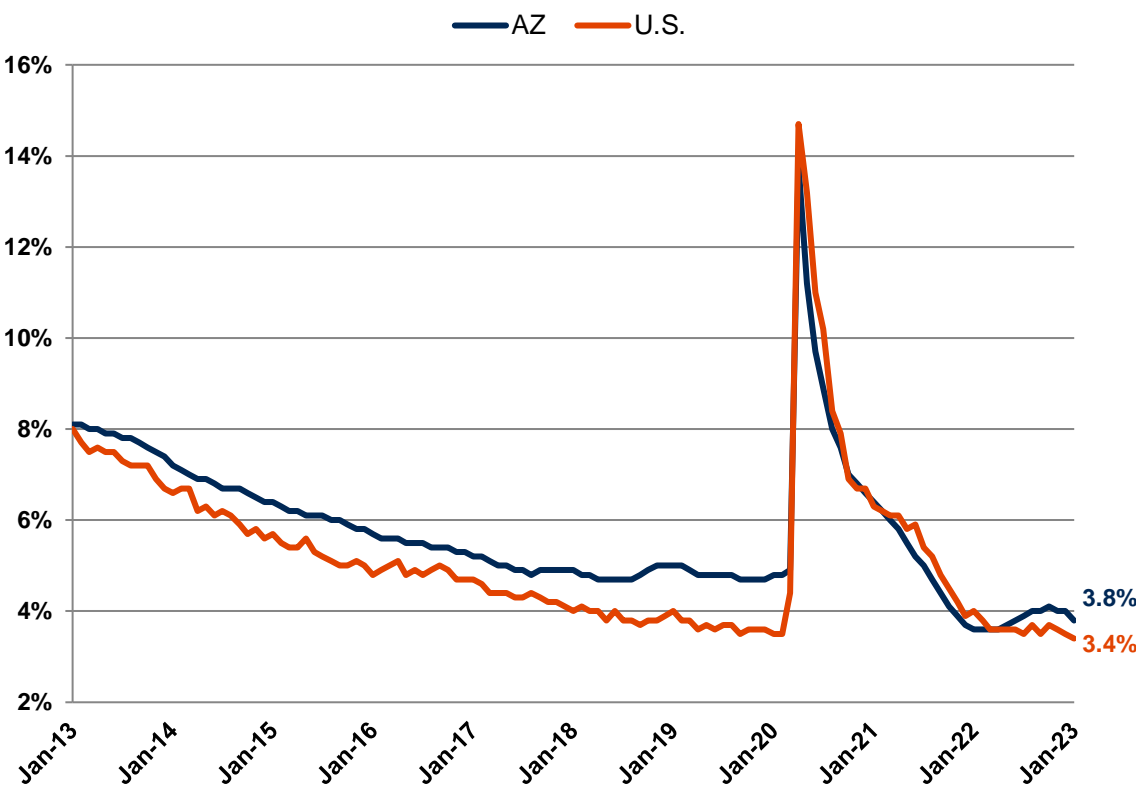

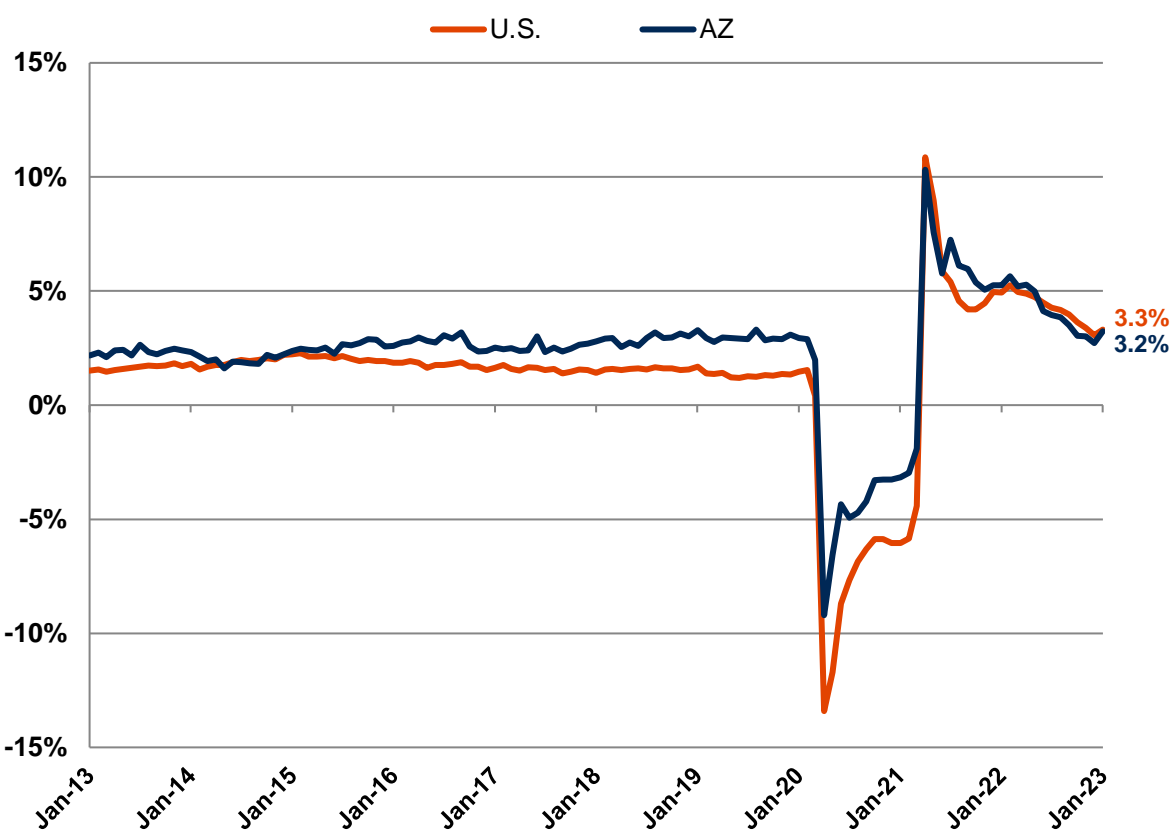
Arizona & U.S. Unemployment Rate

Seasonally Adjusted



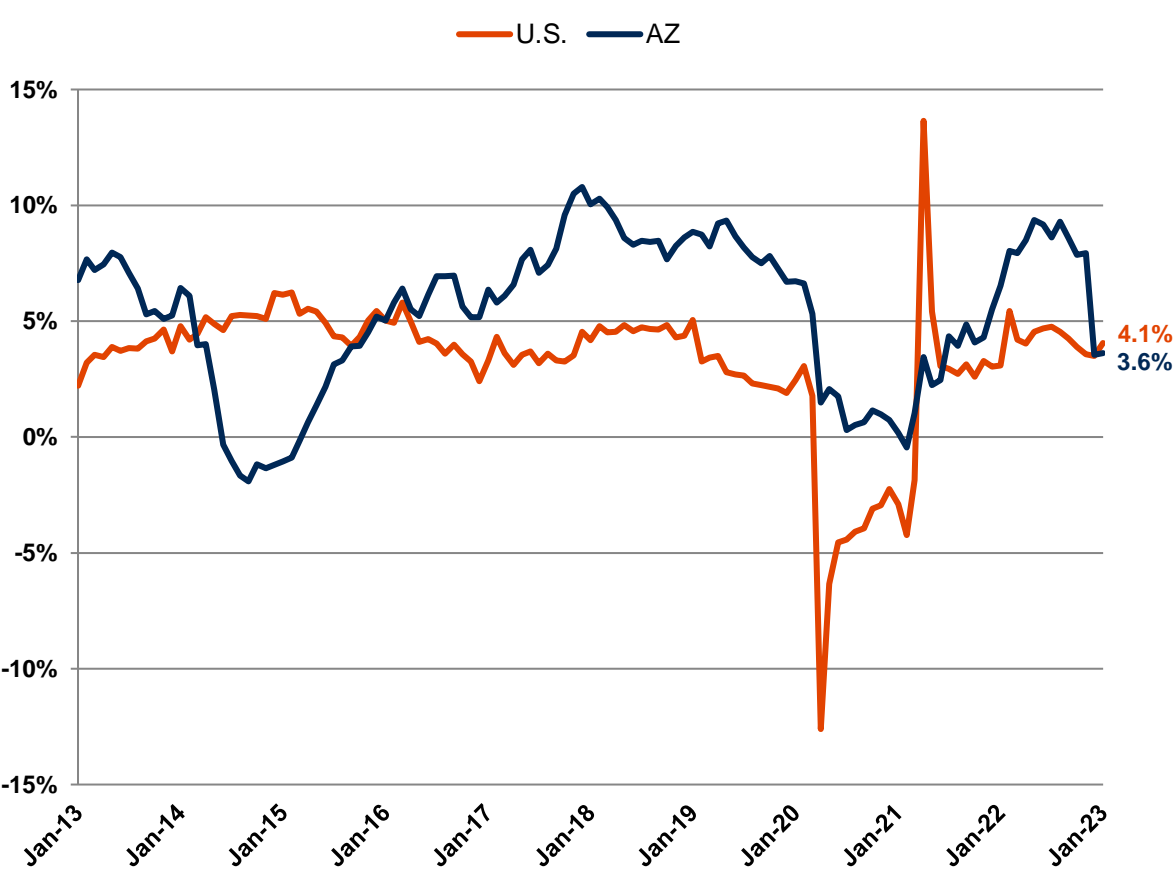
Arizona & U.S. Nonfarm Employment

Year-to-Year Percent Change



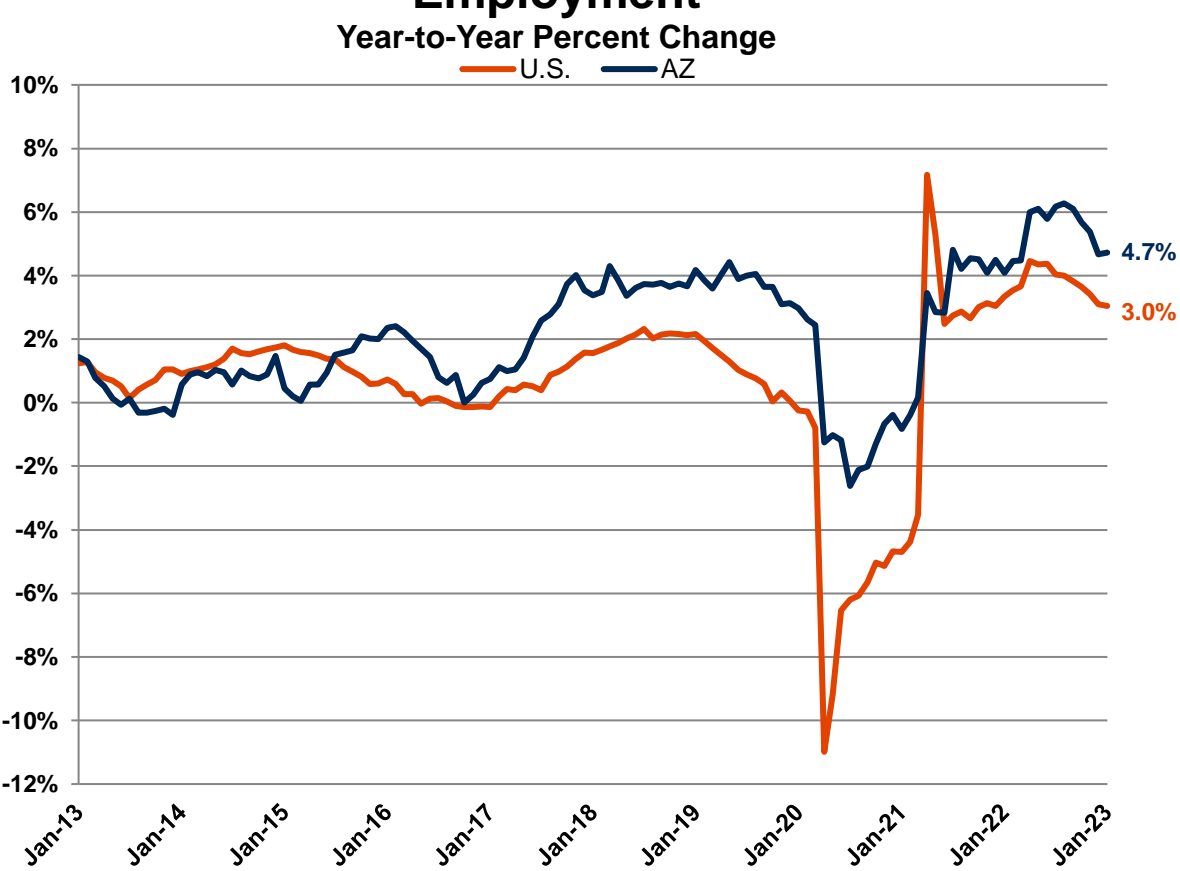
Arizona & U.S. Construction Employment

Arizona & U.S. Manufacturing Employment

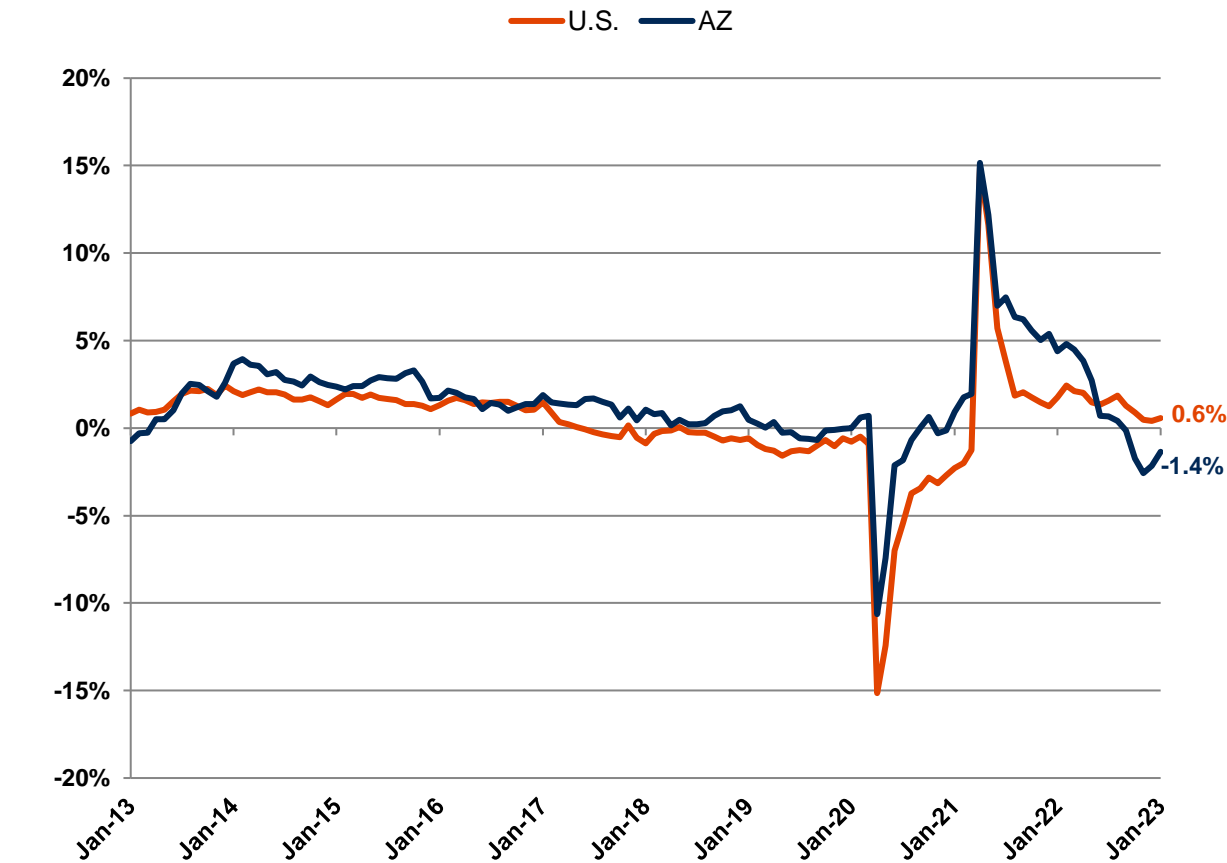
Year-to-Year Percent Change



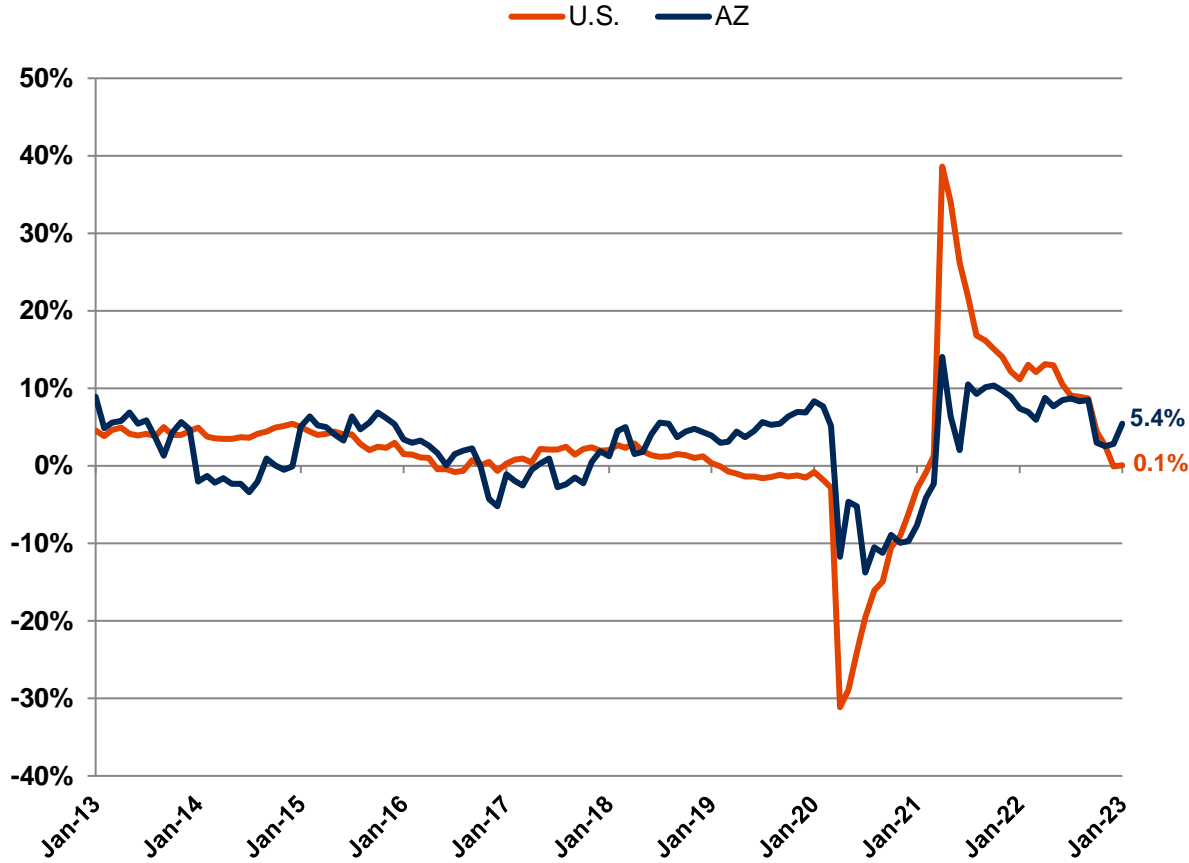

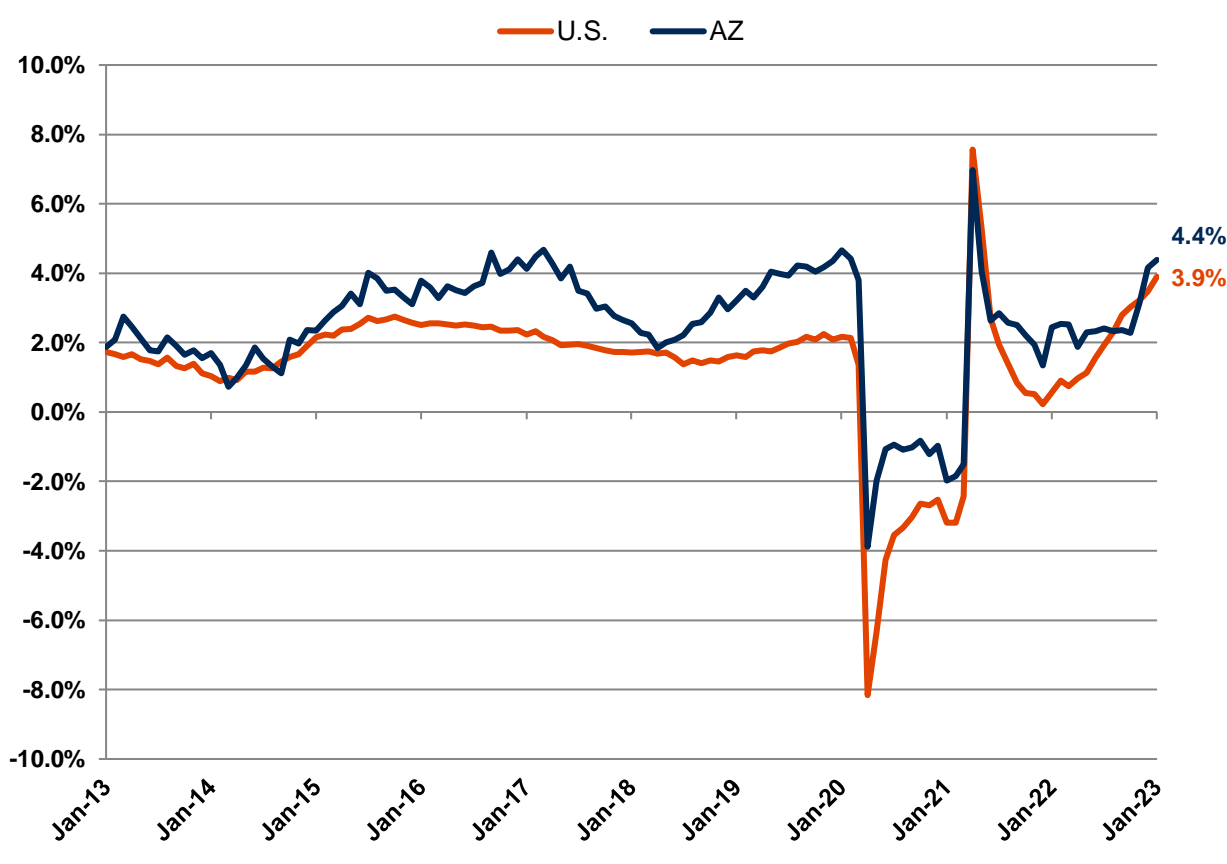
Arizona & U.S. Retail Trade
Year-to-Year Percent Change



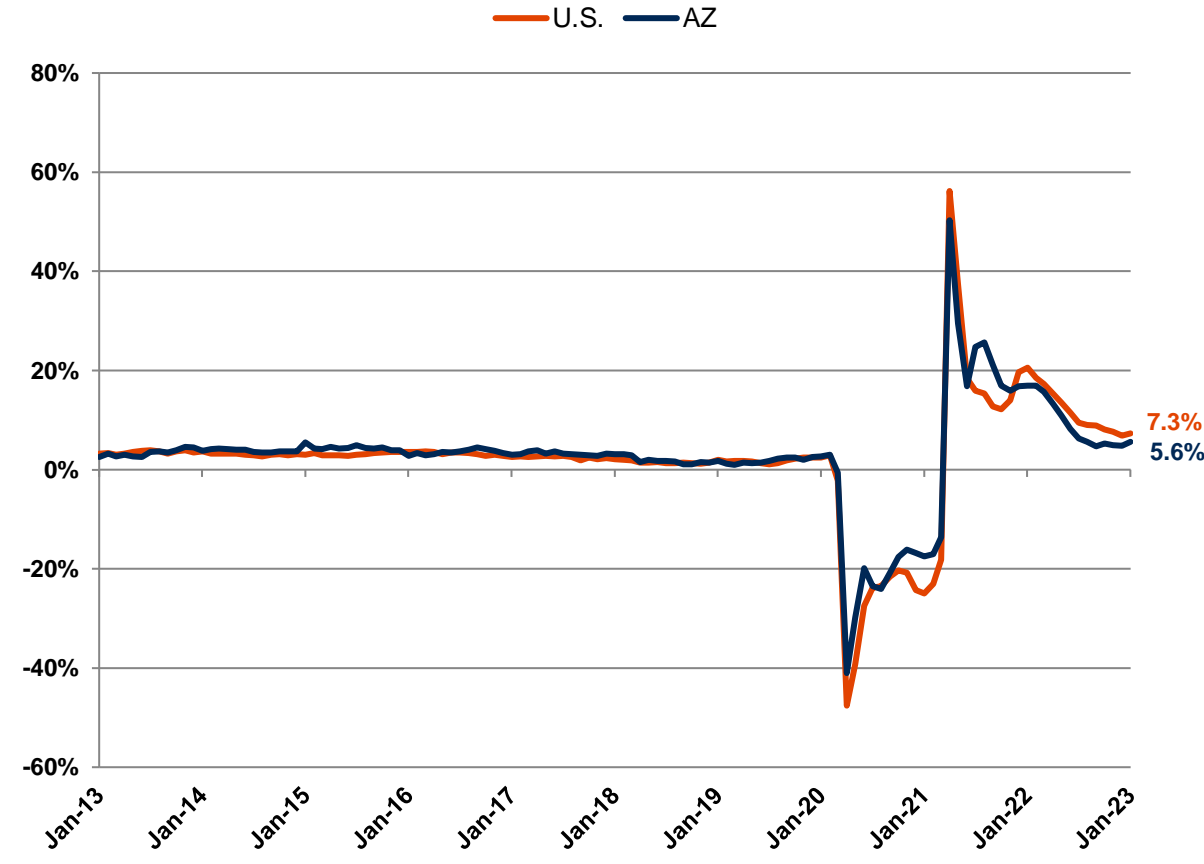
Arizona & U.S. Employment Services
