- ii. Providers must submit:
 - 1. Tower data and propagation models
 - a. GeoJSON or KMZ file format. Only a single GIS file can be uploaded into the Navigator. Multiple GIS files are not supported.
 - 2. Evidence of interference mitigation and network capacity as specified in <u>Appendix A of the Restructuring Policy Notice</u>
 - PDF format. Multiple PDF, word documents are supported. Individual files must not exceed 15MB in size.
- iii. Users are REQUIRED to upload a geospatial file and at least one PDF for submission.
- iv. Each file may not exceed 15 megabytes in size.
- v. Once the correct files have been uploaded, you will see your file loaded and approved with a green checkmark like so:

3. Submission
