### Total Nonfarm Employment Increased by 127,400 Jobs Year Over Year in January 2022 Arizona Unemployment Rate Decreased to 3.7%

The Arizona seasonally adjusted unemployment rate decreased to 3.7% in January 2022 from 3.9% in December 2021. The U.S. seasonally adjusted unemployment rate increased to 4.0% in January 2022 from 3.9% in December 2021. Month over month, Arizona's seasonally adjusted labor force increased by 5,280 individuals or 0.1%. Year over year, the labor force increased by 50,247 individuals or 1.4%. Month over month, Arizona total nonfarm employment decreased by 44,800 jobs or 1.5%. Year over year, total nonfarm employment increased by 127,400 jobs or 4.4%.

#### **Month Over Month**

Arizona nonfarm employment decreased by 44,800 jobs or 1.5% in January. Historically (2012-2021), nonfarm employment has recorded a loss of 49,800 jobs in January. Over-the-month losses are typical for January as demand for seasonal workers declined in industries including Retail Trade, Employment Services, Business Support Services and others. The private sector recorded a loss of 38,400 jobs in January, with losses primarily in Professional and Business Services. The government sector recorded a loss of 6,400 jobs in January, less than the historical average (2012-2021) loss of 8,900 jobs<sup>1</sup>. Historically (2012-2021), private sector employment has averaged a loss of 40,800 jobs in January.

#### Year Over Year

Arizona nonfarm employment increased by 127,400 jobs or 4.4% in January. Gains were recorded in both private sector (123,700 jobs) and government (3,700 jobs) employment, respectively in January.

Gains were reported in all eleven sectors including:

- Leisure & Hospitality (46,600 jobs)
- Trade, Transportation & Utilities (33,600 jobs) •
- Professional & Business Services (9,700 jobs) •
- Education & Health Services (9,300 jobs) •
- Other Services (6,900 jobs) •
- Manufacturing (6,300 jobs) •
- Construction (4,900 jobs) •
- Government (3,700 jobs) •
- Information (3,600 jobs) •
- Financial Activities (2,300 jobs) •
- Natural Resources & Mining (500 jobs)

Because of the COVID-19 pandemic, employment estimates for almost every industry across Arizona in January 2021 recorded larger than average single-month declines. With January 2021 as the comparison point, as the state recovers jobs, employment estimate increases for January are atypically large.

#### Annual Benchmarking Revisions (CES - Establishment Survey Data)

Once a year, the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics (BLS) Current Employment Statistics (CES) program revises its historical employment series for states prior to the release of the January estimates. The CES employment series is revised using detailed employment data produced through the Office of Economic Opportunity's Quarterly Census of Employment and Wages (QCEW) program. QCEW data provides a quarterly count of all employment subject to unemployment insurance tax law. This covers approximately 92% to 95% of total U.S. jobs. Information on the remaining 5% to 8% of employment is obtained from other sources, and the QCEW data is adjusted to obtain a count of total employment within the state.

The process of revising the CES employment series using QCEW employment series is called **benchmarking**, and the new CES employment figures are often referred to as **benchmarked data**. Not all of the historical CES data series can be replaced with QCEW data because of the significant lag between the data collection period and publication period that QCEW data is subject to. For periods in which QCEW data are not yet available, CES estimates are recalculated using the latest QCEW data available along with CES sample data.

During this benchmarking period, QCEW data were available through September 2021. Arizona and sub-state area CES employment estimates were revised using QCEW employment estimates from October 2020 through September 2021. For the periods that QCEW data were not available (October 2021 through December 2021), CES employment estimates were recalculated using CES survey data and updated QCEW data through September 2021. In addition, small historical corrections were incorporated into the data from January 1990 to September 2020.

#### **Changes to Employment Estimates**

Arizona's Nonfarm employment was revised upwards for both 2020 and 2021. The revised 2020 annual average employment for Arizona was 2,853,500 jobs, an upward revision of 3,200 jobs or 0.1% (see Figure 5). The 2020 year-over-year change in Nonfarm employment was revised to -3.0% post-benchmark from -3.1% pre-benchmark. The revised 2021 annual average employment for Arizona was 2,957,600, an upward revision of 12,500 jobs or 0.4% (see Figure 6). The 2021 year-over-year change in Nonfarm employment was revised to 3.8% post-benchmark from 3.3% pre-benchmark.

In 2020, annual average employment was revised upward for Information; Leisure and Hospitality; Construction; Financial Activities; Manufacturing; Trade, Transportation and Utilities; and Professional and Businesses Services. Sectors revised downward include; Education and Health Services; Other Services; Natural Resources and Mining; and Government. **(see Figure 5)**.

In 2021, annual average employment was revised upward for Information; Leisure and Hospitality; Construction; Financial Activities; Government; Manufacturing; Trade Transportation and Utilities; and Professional and Business Services. Sectors revised downward include Education and Health Services, Other Services and Natural Resources and Mining (see Figure 6).
