Purpose of the Permit Finder

The Arizona Commerce Authority's State Broadband Office developed the <u>Permit Finder</u> to help BEAD Subgrantees and Internet Service Providers view permitting requirements in a single, easy-to-use resource, streamlining broadband expansion through a more efficient and transparent process.

The tool identifies which permits are likely required and the agencies that administer them, helping to ensure broadband deployment is both compliant and environmentally responsible across Arizona.



Navigating the **Permit Finder**

Main Menu: Use the left menu to select your BEAD Project Area or enter an address.

Layers: Click "Show/hide Layers" to expand or collapse map layers.



About: Click the "About" button to learn about the tool.

Zoom In/Out:

Zoom and pan to focus on your area of interest.




Finding Agencies and Permit Types

Toggle Views: Switch between "Agencies" and "Permits" by clicking on the panel above the list.

Filter Options:

- Filter agencies by County, Federal, or State level.
- Filter permits by agency or scope using drop down menus.




View Details:

Click an agency or permit to view detailed information, including agency contacts, subagencies, and specific permit requirements.



Exporting Information

Report Title: Enter a report title, then click "Export" to download your customized report.



Export Button:

Click the export button in the agencies or permits panel and select your desired format (PDF, CSV, JSON).
