### Total Nonfarm Employment Increased by 60,000 Jobs Year Over Year in November 2023 Arizona Unemployment Increased to 4.3%

The Arizona seasonally adjusted (SA) unemployment rate increased to 4.3% in November 2023 from 4.2% in October 2023. The U.S. SA unemployment rate decreased to 3.7% in November 2023 from 3.9% in October 2023.

Month over month, Arizona's SA labor force increased by 12,851 individuals, or 0.3%. Year over year, the SA labor force increased by 90,691 individuals, or 2.5%.

Month over month, Arizona not-seasonally adjusted (NSA) total nonfarm employment increased by 35,900 jobs. Year over year, NSA total nonfarm employment increased by 60,000 jobs, or 1.9%. Arizona SA total nonfarm employment increased by 11,500 individuals, or 0.4%, month over month.

#### Month Over Month

Arizona NSA nonfarm employment increased by 35,900 jobs in November. Prior to the pandemic (2010-2019), NSA nonfarm employment gained 28,800 jobs on average in November. The private sector recorded a gain of 35,400 jobs in November, led by gains in Trade, Transportation & Utilities (16,600 jobs) and Professional & Business Services (9,100 jobs). Prior to the pandemic (2010-2019), private sector employment averaged a gain of 27,200 jobs in November. The government sector<sup>1</sup> recorded a gain of 500 jobs in November, less than the pre-pandemic (2010-2019) average gain of 1,600 jobs. Employment gains in the government sector occurred primarily within Local Government Education (800 jobs).



## Year Over Year

Arizona NSA nonfarm employment increased by 60,000 jobs or 1.9% in November year over year. Private sector employment increased by 47,000 jobs year over year, while government employment increased by 13,000 jobs year over year.



### Arizona NSA Year-Over-Year Employment Gain/Loss by Sector






**Arizona & U.S. Unemployment Rate**  
Seasonally Adjusted




**Arizona & U.S. Nonfarm Employment**

Year-to-Year Percent Change




**Arizona & U.S. Manufacturing Employment**  
Year-to-Year Percent Change





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
**Arizona & U.S. Retail Trade**  
Year-to-Year Percent Change




**Arizona & U.S. Employment Services**
